Something a Little Extra this Week:

✖ According to the local paper, The Chronicle – Lewis County Assessor, Dianne Dorey, has announced that the deadline for Senior Exemption/Disabled Persons Property Tax applications is December 31, 2013.

If you are 61 years or older before December 31st of the year you apply, you own your own residence, and your gross income from all sources is \$35,000 or less, you may qualify for an exemption on your property taxes. If you are 100% disabled and have a doctor's statement saying you are 100% disabled at any age, you may also qualify for an exemption if you are the owner of the residence. If you have out-of-pocket prescription costs, in home care, or Part B Medicare, those costs can be deducted from your gross income.
