For tax purposes the IRS says you need to retain receipts and documentation for any deductions or credits you plan to take. After your taxes are filed you need to keep the following for **seven** years:



Tax Returns, receipts, cancelled checks and records for tax deductions taken – The IRS has 3 years from your filing date to audit your return, if it suspects good faith errors. This also applies to amended returns to claim a refund. The IRS has six years to challenge your return if it thinks you underreported your income by 25 percent or more.
